2021 Tellico Trout Festival Fine Art Show

Welcome to the Tellico Plains First Annual Trout Festival. This one day event will be held May 1st from 10am to 5pm in the Historic Town Square. The fine art show will be located on Scott Street. This is a juried show, all artist will need to send 3 photos of their artwork along with their application. The theme is the "FLORA AND FAUNA OF EAST TENNESSEE, ITS MOUNTAINS AND STREAMS AND TROUT ART!"

Two awards for artists include a People's Choice Award (chosen by our visitors for the best Artist Booth): There will be a second award given for Best Trout Art to be awarded by a judge. The artist would submit one piece of art, prominently featuring a native trout of East Tennessee.

- 1. Booth fee is \$35.00. Booth space is 12x12
- 2. Artist are required to supply their own 10x10 tents, tables and chairs. Tables will need to be covered to the ground.
- 3. All Tents must be self-supporting and include weights to prevent wind from toppling it. No spikes may be used in the asphalt to stabilize the tent.
- 4. Artist will need to be set up 1 hour before festival begins.
- 5. Set-up will begin at 6 am on event day. Vendors/exhibitors will be allowed to drive their vehicles into the downtown area and unload starting at 6 am, but must immediately move vehicles. All vehicles must be out of the vendor area not later than 9:00am.
- 6. Artist may not change booth space without the expressed permission of the Art Committee.
- 7. Artist must remain set up for the duration of the festival.
- 8. Personal sound systems in booths are prohibited unless emitted sound is contained to the individual booth.
- 9. Artist will be responsible to keep their area clean and free of trash of any kind.
- 10. Electric power is not available to vendor booths.
- 11. Exhibitor can display or sell only accepted merchandise as listed on the attached application.
- 12. If a vendor or exhibitor violates these event Rules and Regulations, they will be immediately dismissed from the festival and no refund given for the booth fee.
- 13. The Town of Tellico is the Event Organizer and Manager, and the Staff's decisions are final.

Hold Harmless Agreement

Vendors have been advised and understands the Rules and Regulations for the Tellico Trout Festival, and is bound by the terms and conditions outlined by them. Vendor is solely responsible for the quality and safety of what they sell or services they promote. Vendor shall indemnify, keep and hold harmless the Town of Tellico Plains, City commissioners, its employees, and all agencies the Festival has agreements with from and against any and all claims and demands, whether for injuries to persons, or loss of life, or damage to property, on or off the premises, arising out of the use or occupancy of the premises by the vendor and shall defend at the vendor's the own expense any action brought against the Festival and/or any of the above-mentioned organizations or any other person or organization with which the Festival has a contractual relationship by vendor's acts or ommissions.
